Fairfield School: 8-16 years

Fairfield House School offers an inclusive and flexible environment for learning for individuals with ASD and complex needs who may struggle in a large classroom setting. We utilize classroom space as well as community opportunities for learning to impart context and transferrable skills. We also utilise our Fairfield Farm Project to promote a nurturing and sensory environment within our classroom and horticultural facilities.

Fairfield Sixth Form: 16-19 years

Fairfield House School also has a Sixth Form provision with learners from 16-19 years old accessing further education.

Here, the learners are able to further develop their skills in different areas of interest and deepen their progression with everyday transferrable skills that will ultimately increase their independence as young adults in their community.

Skills are taught in a range of settings such as outdoor and indoor community sites, Fairfield Farm Project and our various classroom settings.

Fairfield Adult Learning: 19- 25 years

Fairfield are currently awaiting approval to extend our provision to adults up to 25 years. This will enable individuals to extend their learning further and incorporate extended life and independence skills, employability skills and transferrable functional skills allowing the individual to integrate and maintain their status as an integral member of their own community. With this extra support, individuals can thrive and achieve to their maximum potential.

Our site for this provision will be at our Fairfield Farm Project where we have access to a wide variety of facilities such as a farm based classroom, a workshop pod, a Willow house and a sensory activity area.
